#### Pumpkin Spice Cake -

12 oz. pumpkin puree
3 eggs
1 t. nutmeg
4 c. corn or canola oil
10 oz. sugar
2 t. baking powder
1 t. cinnamon
1 t. baking soda
1 t. ground ginger
6 oz. all purpose flour

In a large bowl whisk together the pumpkin puree, eggs, oil and sugar till well combined. In a separate bowl stir together the rest of the dry ingredients. Fold the dry ingredients into the pumpkin puree mix till well combined. Spread into a greased pan,  $9 \times 13$ . Bake at  $350^{\circ}$  for 30-25 minutes or when a wooden skewer inserted comes out clean. Serve with a dusting of powdered sugar on top or with whip cream.
